Women Ambassadorship Scholarship (WAS)	€ 9.000,-	For people who can showcase eligibility in a 2-3 page essay (1000-1500 words), answering following three questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Leadership and impact:</b> share concrete examples where you took the lead in the challenging gender bias or driving women's empowerment, and highlight the results of your actions.</li> <li>• <b>Overcoming barriers:</b> describe a challenge you faced related to women in leadership and explain how you helped break through it.</li> <li>• <b>Future vision:</b> explain how the MSM MBA or Master in Management will equip you to expand your leadership and continue fighting gender bias and inequality.</li> <li>• And excellent verbal and written communication skills shown in the essay, and the ability to effectively articulate ideas, advocate for women and inspire others.</li> </ul>	2
Excellence in Versatility Scholarship (EVS)	€ 9.000,-	This scholarship reflects a balance of academic merit, leadership, and a proven ability to excel across multiple areas of life (e.g., leadership, arts, sports, social impact etc.). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Candidates should demonstrate Versatility through CV, certifications, awards, additional presentations (ppt, links, blogs, articles, videos)</li> <li>• Candidates must show excellence in at least two or more of the following categories: <p><b>Leadership:</b> Proven leadership roles in organisations (e.g., student councils, entrepreneurial ventures, NGOs, corporate experience).</p> <p><b>Community Involvement:</b> Active participation in community service, social initiatives, or volunteering with a demonstrable impact.</p> <p><b>Arts, Music, or Sports:</b> Outstanding achievements in extracurricular fields such as arts (painting, music, performing arts), sports, or cultural representation.</p> <p><b>Entrepreneurship/Innovation:</b> Evidence of innovative projects, start-ups, or creative contributions in professional settings.</p> <p><b>Multilingual Proficiency:</b> Fluency in at least two languages beyond their native language.</p> <p><b>Personal Statement:</b> Candidates must submit a 500-750 word personal statement describing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How they have demonstrated versatility across various domains.</li> <li>• Why they believe they deserve the EVS scholarship.</li> <li>• How they plan to leverage their versatility to contribute to the Maastricht School of Management and the global community (Candidates must express a clear commitment to actively contribute to the MSM community during their year at MSM).</li> </ul> </p> </li> </ul>	2

The vision statement should reflect originality, creativity, and a deep understanding of the potential of technology and/or innovation in their chosen field.</li> <li>• Candidates need to highlight hands-on experience and knowledge (e.g., coding, projects, startups etc.) and provide proof through a CV, portfolio, certifications or references.</li> <li>• A strong commitment to using technology and/or innovation for social good, with specific examples of positive impact and/or experience with cutting-edge technologies (e.g., AI, blockchain) and related research or development is a plus.</li> </ul>	Unlimited
Creative Industry Scholarship	15%	Awarded to individuals who have demonstrated leadership in the creative sectors, such as arts, design, media, and entertainment. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Candidates must have completed a study related to the creative industries or have work experience related to this field (e.g., media, design, fine arts, performing arts, digital arts, fashion, film, etc)</li> <li>• Submission of a portfolio, website, video (or any other creative examples) showcasing the applicant's creative work (could include designs, artworks, performances, films, etc.).</li> </ul>	Unlimited
Healthcare Management Scholarship	15%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicants must show knowledge/ experience in their CV/ through certifications and/ or references in healthcare management or related fields, with a focus on improving the efficiency, accessibility, and quality of healthcare systems. Involvement in community healthcare programs, public health initiatives, or volunteer work related to improving public health outcomes is an advantage.</li> <li>• Submission of a written essay or short 1-2 minute video detailing the applicant's career goals in healthcare management and their vision for contributing to the healthcare sector. Applicants should describe any relevant experience that demonstrates their understanding of healthcare challenges and their commitment to addressing them. Applicants should illustrate how they have made a positive impact in healthcare or wellness initiatives within their communities.</li> </ul>	Unlimited
Community Leadership Scholarship	15%	For candidates who have made significant contributions to their communities through demonstrated leadership in community projects, volunteer work, or initiatives that have had a positive social impact. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In a short 1-2 minute video, the candidate must showcase his/her passion for and experiences in addressing social, environmental, or economic challenges through leadership and service, as well as mentioned future goals, and vision for creating change in their community.</li> <li>• Submit a reference/ proof of community work from individuals who can speak to the applicant's leadership and community involvement.</li> </ul>	Unlimited
